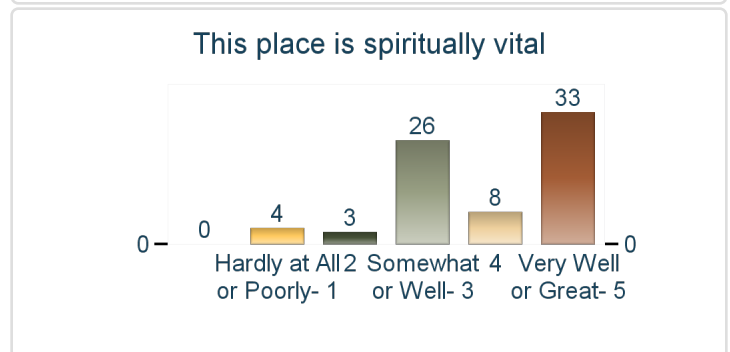
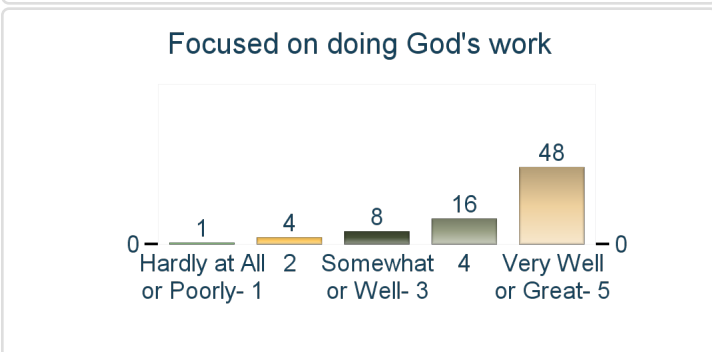
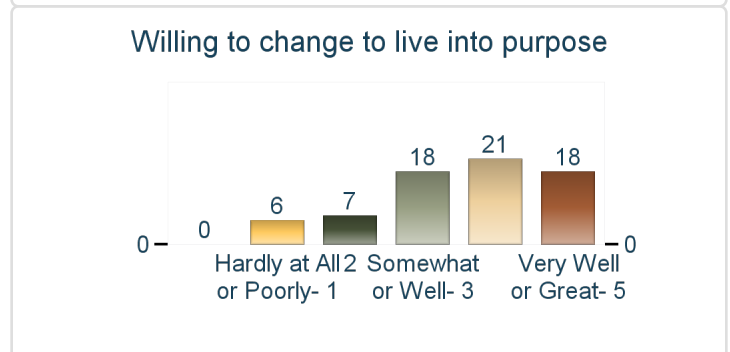
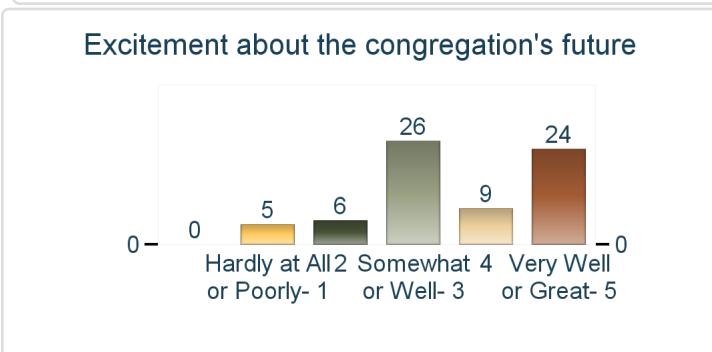
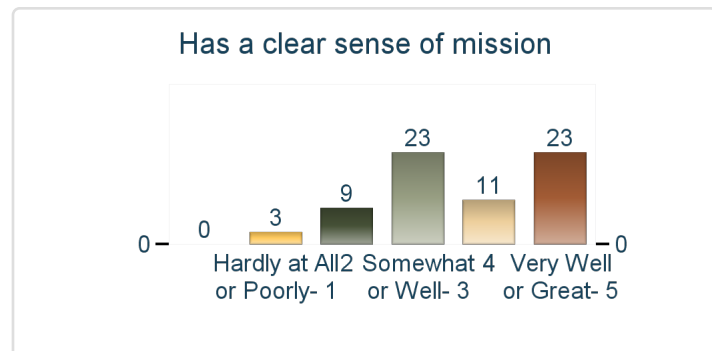
Bar Chart Report

This report is a complement to the Comprehensive Vitality Survey. Below a chart is presented each item presented in the God, Each other and World scales. These charts show how many individuals selected each response (1-5). Note, skipped responses or "don't know" responses are not included.

When interpreting these responses, look at the shape of the chart. Thriving congregations typically have most respondents rating most items 5 followed by 4, 3, etc. Stable and sometimes stagnant congregations often have 4 as the common response on many items. Struggling congregations tend to have 3 as the most common response on many items. Look out for items with a U or W shape (many people rating the same item high and low. This suggests there is disagreement either about how what the question meant or what is happening in the congregation.

It is not uncommon to have a few people rate items differently than the majority. This indicates that those people are having a different experience from the majority. Their ratings should be honored as true reflections of their experience. Respectful conversations about those differences can further the mission of the congregation.

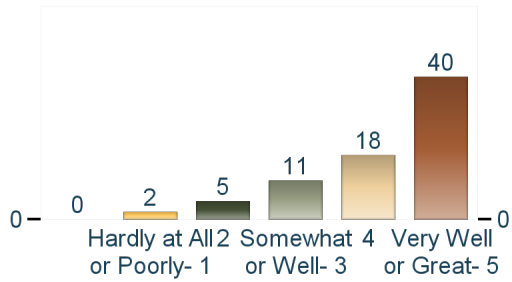
